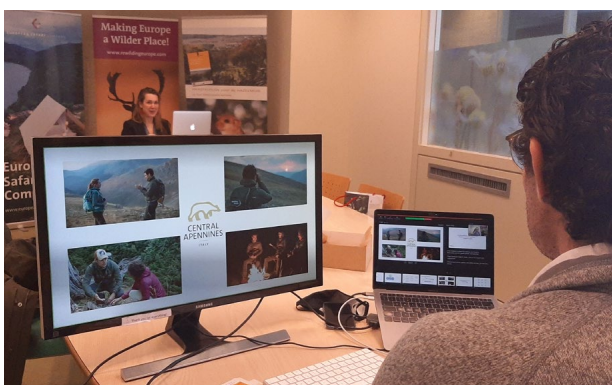
OUR NEW TWO STAGED TRAINING PROGRAMME

STAGE 1

ONLINE TRAINING AND SELECTION

A series of three webinar training presentations for all candidates, including an introduction to rewilding, rewilding models & principles, natural grazing, community engagement, and nature-based economies.



STAGE 2

IN-FIELD TRAINING

A two-day field training programme for a maximum of 15 participants. Bringing people together to learn and train in different environments across rewilding areas.

STAGE 2

Programme overview

Participants will benefit from a range of activities and exercises carried out against the backdrop of beautiful and developing rewilding areas.

Areas covered include:

- Rewilding in practice: Implement and integrating rewilding;
- Natural grazing: the role of natural grazers in action;
- Rewilding models at work;
- Enterprise models as part of the rewilding solution (nature based economies);
- Community, enterprise and communication insights: why Rewilding has three critical pillars of engagement.

This field training is limited to a maximum of fifteen participants.
