Role

With Rewilding Europe growing and striving, the role of the Communications Officer is firstly supporting Rewilding Europe's Communications Team in their various communication activities and secondly to bring internal communications to the next level. The Communications Officer will act as a connector, communicator and spider in the web. The Communications Officer reports to the Head of Communications and works closely together with the Communications Team and Finance & Operations Team (with regards to internal communications).

Main responsibilities

The main responsibilities of the Communications Officer are:

- Supports the production of promotional and communications materials.
- Responsible for internal communications (e.g. newsletters, organisational updates, mailings, news updates).
- Prepares posts for social media channels in collaboration with the Communication Managers.
- Supports website management (uploading content, search engine optimization).
- Helps organising (internal) events.
- Manages the external contacts and press list.
- Maintains and develops Rewilding Europe's image and footage databank.
- Reviews newsletters, reports and partner updates to generate items to be used by Rewilding Europe in their communications.

Key qualifications

- Appropriate qualification in communications.
- Demonstrable experience and understanding of communications best practices.
- Background or knowledge in ecology and nature highly recommendable
- Excellent in English.
- Good writing skills and being able to compose engaging and accurate content.
- Knowledge of modern communication tools, preferably including Wordpress, Social Media, Google Analytics and basic knowledge of design programs such as Indesign, Illustrator and Canva.
- Passionate about Rewilding Europe's mission, vision and objectives.
